Questions for Coverack School parents

- 1. Our intention is to request an extension of the consultation period for a further year in order to:
 - a) allow the community to support the school in proving that pupil numbers will rise, or if need be
 - b) give parents a fairer chance of finding a place in a good local school.

Should this not be achieved, and we have to revert to the 1½ class model (two classes in the morning KS1 and KS2, and one combined class in the afternoon supported by expertise from members of the community) would you choose to keep your child at Coverack school or would you opt to move to another school?

2. If we can achieve an extension to the consultation period, we intend to put in place a breakfast club and after-school care. Would you consider taking up this opportunity?
