The Church Roof work will commence with scaffolding being erected the third week in September. We are delighted to have Mr Henry Blight of Lizard Roofing doing the work. From the third week of September until mid-October there will be restricted access though the church yard from Chymbloth Way down via the Hall. It will be possible to visit graves via the Lychgate entrance, but it will be safer to use the walkways between the graves to reach a particular place. On Sundays the Church will be open for the morning service and until 1600 for prayer. The PCC committee are grateful to all who have contributed to the funds so far, with over £20,000 raised.
