The Scaffolding is up, and Mr Henry Blight of Lizard Roofing has started the work to remove the slates and to renew the waterproof membrane and battens. The slates will then be refitted with new copper nails. The PCC need to reach out to the wider community to continue fund raising to meet the increased costs since Covid. Thank you to all those who have so generously donated. We are continuing fund raising to enable us to complete the work as soon as possible, before the winter weather is upon us. To delay would be foolish - with help from the community we trust we can make this happen.
